- WIC Program – Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children
 - Federal grants that support supplemental food, health care referrals, and nutrition education
 - Mothers and their children, up to the child’s 5th birthday, will qualify for resources and support under WIC
 - If you qualify for Medicaid or SNAP benefits, you automatically qualify for WIC

 - Part of larger school programs to assist with food insecurity among school-aged children. All teenagers and children 18 and under are fed meals free of charge
